

Certificate of Origin

Some countries require a Certificate of Origin with imports. An authorised Certificate of Origin provides this proof and South Dublin Chamber is authorised by the Department of Enterprise Trade & Employment to issue Export Documentation and Certificates of Origin. The type of Certificate required varies according to the destination of the goods, e.g. member States of the Arab League require an (Arab-Irish Certificate Origin). European Union countries require a European Union Certificate of Origin (EU Certificate)


