Dear Members,

Our recent South Dublin County Business Awards brought home to all who attended the wide diversity of business in our county covering all sectors and representing the smallest one-person business to our multinational sector. In looking around the room you could see the energy, determination and commitment of those businesses to succeed.

What our business community needs most to enable this success to continue is stability in our economy and investment in infrastructure. We are all aware of the housing issue. What is less evident but equally impactful for business is the need to invest in water supplies and treatment, the need to generate energy and be able to distribute it. We welcome the measures in the budget which are a step towards addressing these issues.

Over the next 12 months, our economy appears set to continue growing, but with clear signs of moderation and increased risk. According to the European Commission, real GDP growth in Ireland is projected at 3.4% in 2025, down from a stronger pace in recent years. Much of the domestic economy remains resilient – a tight labour market, relatively low unemployment, and steady household spending provide a solid base.

However, there are a number of headwinds. Ireland's large exposure to multinational corporations – especially in the U.S.-linked pharmaceutical and tech sectors – means external risks loom large: increased protectionism, U.S. tariff moves, or global trade disruption could dent exports and tax revenue. On the domestic side, investment is expected to remain subdued in the face of uncertainty, which limits upside potential.

For us here in South Dublin County our local and national economy are significantly aligned and integrated. It is likely our economy will keep growing at a moderate pace over the next year, backed by strong domestic fundamentals, yet negatively constrained by external risks and investment caution.

Our business community are a key part of our wider community providing jobs, services and taxes to enable us to have a strong education sector which has been and will continue to be a key determinate of our future growth.

Brexit



Despite Brexit, the EU and the UK continue to share a unique relationship rooted in common interests, values, and perspectives.

Peter Byrne CEO South Dublin Chamber is Co Rapporteur of the European Economic & Social Committee's Opinion on the review of EU UK Trade and Co-operation Agreement which will take place next year. He spoke on in Plenary recently proposing the opinion, "Looking to the

future of EU-UK relations 2026 TCA review from a civil society perspective."

On 16 July 2025, this motion was passed with 147 votes in favour, none against, and two abstentions. It will now become the EESC's view on the TCA. We shall, as South Dublin Chamber, use this opinion to have high level meetings with the Departments of Enterprise and Trade and the Department of Foreign Affairs.

The Trade and Cooperation Agreement (TCA) provides the legal framework for bilateral trade. While governments focus on implementing the TCA, business experiences it daily. The TCAs legally required five-year review is set for 2026 and now is the time to consider how it is working.

Lucan House - A New Chapter for a Historic Landmark



Lucan House: From Ambassador's Estate to People's Park

Lucan House and Demesne to be transformed into a visitor attraction along the banks of the River Liffey.

A New Chapter for a Historic Landmark

South Dublin County Council recently purchased Lucan House, a magnificent 18th-century Palladian mansion set within 12 hectares of mature woodland along the River Liffey.

Formerly the private residence of Italian ambassadors, Lucan House was acquired by the Council in late 2024. For the first time since the 1940s, the estate's gates will remain open — and the house and grounds will become a shared space for all.

A Place of History and Heritage

Lucan House is a rare civic treasure, steeped in layers of history:

- Remnants of a medieval tower house lie beneath its grounds.
- The mansion's interiors showcase decorative plasterwork by Michael Stapleton, one of Ireland's master craftsmen.
- Once secluded, the estate is now being thoughtfully restored and reimagined as a public cultural and ecological landmark.

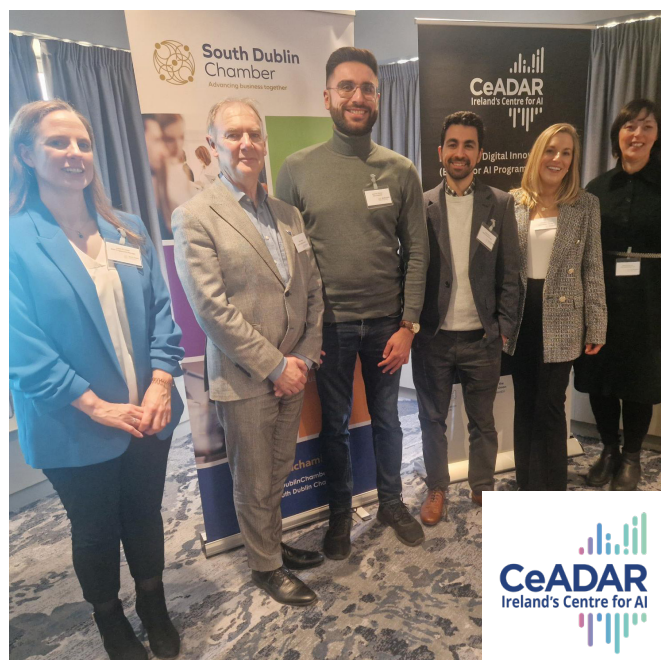

Wilsons Auctions Dublin Celebrates 25 Years of Auction Excellence

Wilsons Auctions is proud to mark a major milestone this year as its Dublin branch celebrates 25 years in business. Since opening its doors in 2000, the branch has grown from a modest 16,000 square foot shed on Sir John Rogerson's Quay to Ireland's largest auction facility, now occupying a 21-acre site at Kingswood Interchange on the Naas Road.

Wilsons Auctions, originally founded in Northern Ireland, expanded into Dublin in 2000, marking a significant milestone in the company's growth. The Dublin branch began in a modest 16,000 square foot shed on Sir John Rogerson's Quay, close to the city's Docklands. With just three full-time staff and a single car auction held fortnightly, the branch quickly established and as demand grew, car auctions became a weekly event.

By 2004, the branch had relocated to a new auction centre at Kingswood Cross, Naas Road. This 3.5-acre site enabled immediate expansion, introducing auctions for vans, plant and machinery, HGVs, catering equipment, and disposal assets. The move also allowed the development of corporate services and offsite auction teams, further broadening the branch's capabilities.

In 2012, Wilsons Auctions Dublin moved again, this time to its current site at Kingswood Interchange. The new premises offered 21 acres, including 80,000 square feet of buildings and offices, providing the scale needed to support the company's growing operations and ambition.

In 2023, the Dublin branch underwent a €1 million refurbishment, transforming its customer-facing areas and staff facilities. The investment introduced a modern reception, upgraded meeting rooms, and a state-of-the-art vehicle photobooth to enhance online auction presentation. Electric vehicle charging points were also installed, reflecting the company's commitment to sustainability and future mobility.

Wilsons Auctions Dublin is now part of a network of 19 locations, with ten main auction centres across Ireland and the UK and nine satellite sites for online auctions and secure storage. The company's national coverage allows it to draw on experience and resources from all branches, making it the only auction company in Ireland and the UK with such reach.

2025 saw the launch of GAVEL, Wilsons Auctions' proprietary auction management platform. Developed in-house over four years, GAVEL has revolutionised the auction experience for both staff and customers. The platform streamlines cataloguing, bidding, and reporting, offering real-time visibility and enhanced compliance across all auction formats.

Reflecting on the anniversary, Ricky Wilson, Director of Wilsons Auctions, said: "It's hard to believe it's been 25 years since we opened our Dublin branch. From humble beginnings to becoming Ireland's largest auction facility, this journey has been one of growth, resilience, and innovation. I'm incredibly proud of our team and grateful to our clients and customers who have supported us every step of the way. Here's to the next 25 years!"

With over 3,200 auctions conducted annually and a hammer total exceeding £620 million, Wilsons Auctions remains the largest independently owned auction company in Ireland

and the UK and will celebrate 90 years since establishing the business at Headquarters in Belfast. The Dublin branch continues to play a pivotal role in this success, offering a full suite of auction services across vehicles, property, plant and machinery, luxury goods, and more.

Wilsons Auctions was formed in 1936 by William J Wilson, trading from one site in Mallusk, Co. Antrim. The company has since flourished with son, Ian Wilson taking over as Managing Director in 1976, expanding to a total of eighteen sites across Northern Ireland, Scotland, Republic of Ireland, England and Wales.

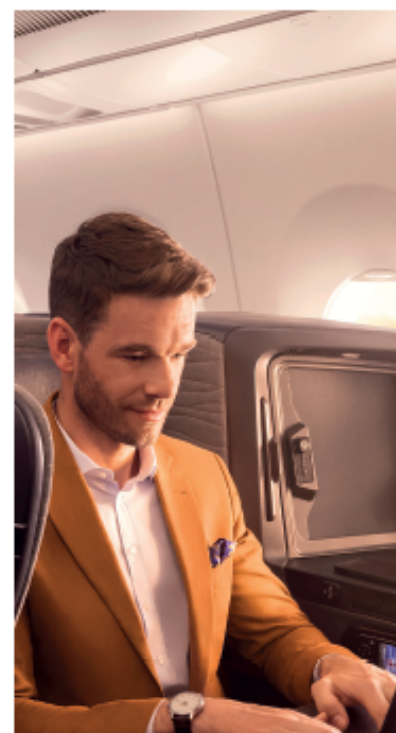

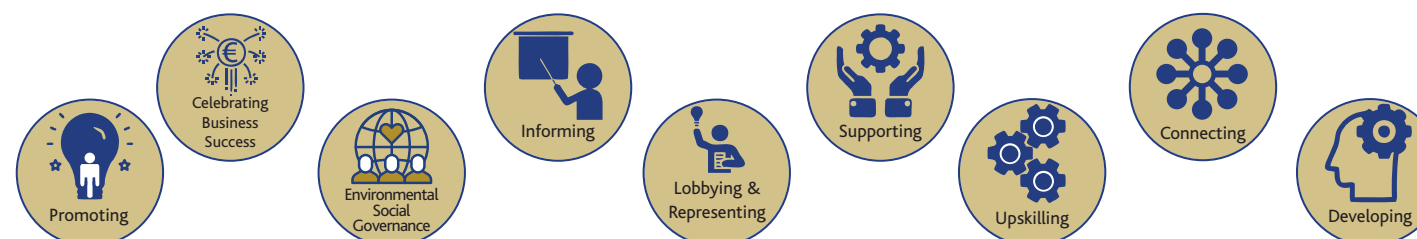
